# NAAC AWARENESS WORKSHOP ON ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION FOR NON-ACCREDITED AFFILIATED COLLEGES OF UNIVERSITY OF MYSORE

As part of the Centenary Celebrations of the University of Mysore, Mysuru, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized the "NAAC Awareness Workshop on Assessment and Accreditation" in association with Planning Monitoring and Evaluation Board (PMEB) and College Development Council (CDC) of University of Mysore, during 24th & 25th of August 2015. The workshop was sponsored by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bengaluru under National Quality Renaissance Initiative. The aim of the workshop was to enlighten the participants on the methodology and procedures followed in assessment and accreditation of colleges and thus promote quality in higher education. Failure to get NAAC accreditation may lead to discontinuation of financial assistance to the Colleges/Institutions by the UGC/Government; hence the workshop was organized for the benefit of non-accredited colleges of University of Mysore.

An organizing committee was formed with Prof. K. S. Rangappa, Vice Chancellor as the Chief Patron and Prof. C. Basavaraju, Registrar, Prof. K. A. Raveesha, Director, IQAC, Prof. S. Ravi, Director, PMEB, Prof. C. Lingaraj Gandhi, Director, CDC and Mr. Roopraj Chandan, Joint Director, Department of Collegiate Education, Mysuru region as members. The Committee met many times to discuss and formulate the modalities of the workshop. In order to provide representation to all non-accredited colleges, it was resolved to restrict the number of representatives to one per college. All the colleges were intimated about the dates of workshop and were asked to register with in the last date prescribed. The selected participants were informed individually by email and SMS and the list was also published in the university website.

A total of 121 participants registered and attended the workshop. The participants were not charged any fee. All the participants were provided a registration kit comprising of a bag, writing materials and the programme schedule. The workshop was inaugurated on 24th August 2015 at 10.30 AM by Prof. H. A. Ranganath, Former Director, NAAC & Former Vice Chancellor, Bangalore University at Rani Bahadur Auditorium, Bahadur Institute of Management Studies (BIMS), Manasagangotri, Mysuru followed by a key note address. Prof. K. S. Rangappa, Vice Chancellor, University of Mysore presided over the function and delivered the presidential address. Experts in the field were invited as resource persons and criteria wise specific topics were presented by them. The workshop included a panel discussion session with experts for detailed interaction of participants with the resource persons. Valedictory function of the workshop was held on 25th August at 5.00 PM and Prof. C. Basavaraju, Registrar, University of Mysore delivered the valedictory address.



### WORKSHOP STRUCTURE AND CONTENT

DAY 01: 24 August 2015 Session 1: Inauguration

Inauguration of the workshop was held on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2015 at 10.30 AM at Rani Bahadur Auditorium, Bahadur Institute of Management Studies (BIMS), University of Mysore (UOM), Manasagangotri, Mysuru. Many educational administrators, eminent academicians, educationists, media persons, teaching faculty and other dignitaries attended the function. Wide publicity about the workshop was given in the media and university website.

The programme started with an invocation song followed by centenary theme song of the university by the students of Fine Arts College, UOM.

Director, Collegiate education, Mysuru region.




brought to the notice of gathering that such of the colleges which do not get accredited may lose the government grants.

### Session 2:

The session started at 11.45 AM after the tea break. During this session the key note address was delivered by Prof. H. A. Ranganath, Former Director NAAC & Former Vice Chancellor, Bangalore University.

Dr. K. V. Prabhakara, Principal, Mahajana College, Mysuru shared the experience of the college with regard to NAAC accreditation process. He explained the absolute necessity of colleges to get accredited and highlighted the benefits that his college derived due to NAAC accreditation. He also provided valuable inputs for getting better accreditation status.

### **Session 4: Panel Discussion**

The last session of the first day of the workshop was dedicated to panel discussion. The resource persons of the panel were trained and experienced NAAC assessors.



During the session, many participants sought clarifications regarding the NAAC assessment. All the seven criteria adapted by NAAC for assessment and accreditation were discussed in detail. The participants also discussed about the problems and prospects of accreditation of their colleges and sought solutions from the experts. The panel clarified all the doubts of the participants and promised to guide them through.

### DAY 02: 25 August 2015

### **Session 1:**

On the second day, the first session started at 10.30 AM. During this session Prof. S. N. Hegde, Former Vice Chancellor, University of Mysore, discussed in detail Criteria I - curricular aspects, Criteria II - teaching, learning, evaluation and Criteria III - research, consultancy and extension. The interactive presentation resulted in a healthy and useful discussion.



### Session 2:

Following the tea break, the next session was accomplished by Prof. P. Venkataramaiah, Former Vice Chancellor, Kuvempu University. He delivered a lecture on Criteria IV and V which deal with the infrastructure & learning resources and student support and progression respectively.

During his presentation, he focused on the need of physical infrastructure



such as playground, auditorium, ICT enabled class rooms, teaching aids, multimedia projections etc. He mentioned the importance of learning resources such as laboratories, library, books, journals, newsletters, periodicals and internet in the learning process. He highlighted role of alumni and other stakeholders. The need to document student support and progression was also discussed.

### Session 3:

The third session of day two started after the lunch break. Prof. R. Indira, Former Director, International Center, University of Mysore discussed about criteria VI and VII which included governance & leadership and innovative practices.

She highlighted the role of NCC, NSS and other organizational committees in the governance and leadership activities of the colleges. The need for college based innovative practices in curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities was discussed.

### Session 4:

This session started after the tea break. During this session, Dr. Sujatha P. Shanbhag, NAAC Officer, Bengaluru, explained in detail the process involved in assessment and accreditation of colleges by NAAC.





She explained in detail the eligibility criteria for colleges to get accredited. The procedures to be adopted by the college right from the Letter of intent (LOI), fee details, Institutional eligibility for quality

assessment (IEQA), Preparation and submission of self-study report (SSR) were explained. Further, she explained about the constitution of the peer team committee, peer team visit, visit schedule, peer team report, score sheet and award of the grade by NAAC. All the questions raised by the participants were also clarified after the presentation.


During the valedictory programme, the participants were provided with sufficient time to share their experiences.






Participants expressing opinion about the workshop.
