- > It must be specifically mentioned that the post-graduate department was shifted to its present location only in 1962, and it was earlier situated at Maharaja's College.
- >Dr. B. Kuppuswamy, renowned social psychologist, and Prof. B. Krishnan, known for his work on Indian Psychology, led the department for a long time, and to its present glory.

MILESTONES

- >Major Achievements of Prof. Gopalaswamy :
- i. The first Professor of Psychology in the country.
- ii. The founder of first psychology laboratory in South India.
- iii. The founder of "Akashvani"
- >Major Achievements of Prof. B Krishnan:
- i. Establishment of Bio-Psychology Laboratory.
- ii. Developed Mysore Personality Inventory, Cyclothymic/Schizothyme Test and Study Habits Inventory.
- iii. Started the journal Psychological Studies, in 1956 and edited it till his retirement in 1977.
- > Socio-Economic Scale (SES) developed by Dr. B Kuppuswamythat is extensively used in research till date.
- >Development of Mysore Aptitude Test Battery by Dr. M. Parashivamurthy.
- >Dr. T.R. Rao published several books in various fields of Psychology. His most notable contribution was the books written on technical subjects in Kannada back in 1970s.

CURRICULUM

- >MSc in Clinical Psychology
- > The course offers in-depth knowledge in on diagnosing and treating emotional, mental, and behavioral disorders.
- > The curriculum is designed with specific focus on providing hands on experience for practical learning.
- > The Course is divided into 4 semesters, each carefully designed to meet the students learning requirements.
- > The curriculum consists of Theory (Hard Core papers, Soft Core papers, and Open Elective), Practical, Tutorial, Field Placement (Internship), and Dissertation work.

CURRICULUM

- >Ph.D. in Psychology
- > Scholars go through rigorous training in the form of Course Work offered to equip them with through understanding on literature review, research methodology and statistical procedures for data analysis so as to bring out quality work in the discipline.
- > The department also offers opportunities for interdisciplinary research.
- > Well equipped and trained faculties guide and supervise the Ph.D. work.
- > The course includes Research Methodology Paper, Review of Literature Paper, Viva-voce, Course Work and Written Exam.
