The Department of studies in Urdu at Manasagangotri was established in 1959. Earlier, M.A. Urdu and Persian languages courses were offered at Maharaja's College, Mysore. The University of Mysore was the first to offer full fledged Urdu courses both at Under-graduate and Post-graduate levels in South India. The department was earlier housed in Maharaja's college, Mysore and later shifted to Humanities Block at Manasagangotri, Mysore and has a full-fledged infrastructure and facility for teaching and research.

The department's vision is to preserve the rich cultural heritage of the Urdu language, literature and art forms like calligraphy, painting, Ghazal singing and promote Urdu Language and literature through teaching and research.
