The University of Mysore established the Institute of

Development Studies (IDS) in 1971. The IDS is an Inter disciplinary

center in the field of development which includes teaching, training and research. The focus of the

Institute ever since its inception has been on analyzing the different dimensions of development – physical, socio-political, economic and environmental to mention the major ones. The scope is to equipping students with the basic knowledge and skills necessary for perceiving and analyzing the problems encountered in development and agri-business and finding the appropriate solutions for them. The beginning of the Institute was modest. physically located in the Department of Geography, The Institute received a grant from the Government of Karnataka to take up research projects concerning development and planning. In the initial 5 years, the Institute functioned mainly as a clearing house for projects entrusted to teachers in the different departments of the University. The Institute owes its gratitude to the founders namely Prof.D.Javare Gowda, the then Vice-Chancellor, Dr.R.P.Mishra founder Director and D.V.Urs, the then Registrar.

The Ford Foundation while appreciating the research and training activities of the Institute, made liberal grants during 1977 for acquiring the present building Leela Vihar, Books for Library and to undertake study visits by the faculty of the Institute. The Institute owes its gratitude to Ford Foundation in strengthening the basic infrastructure of the Institute.
