## ACADEMIC DEPARTMENTS

### Department of Bioscience

The M.Sc. course in Bioscience was started in 1993. The main objective of the course is interdisciplinary studies in Bio-chemistry, Bio- technology, Botany, Zoology and Microbiology. The Department also offers Ph.D. degree in Bioscience.

## 2. Department of Electronics

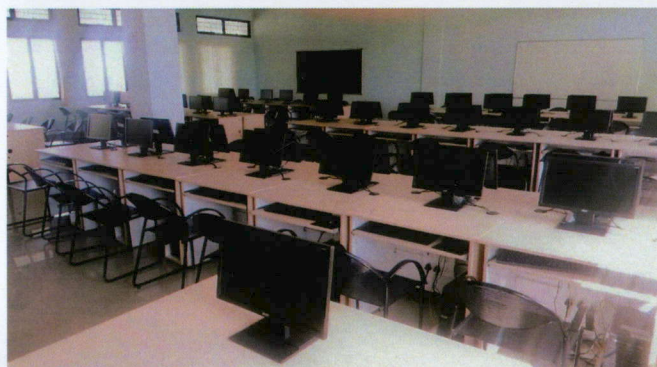

## INFRASTRUCTURE

Infrastructure of the Centre comprises Academic Blocks to serve the nine departments, with classrooms, laboratories for students and faculty. The campus houses the Library and Information Centre, Computer Lab, Administrative wing, Auditorium, Hostel, Canteen and Playground. Staff quarters for teaching and non-teaching staff also exists in the campus.

## LIBRARY

Hemagangotri library possesses around 25,000 books in stock for several disciplines of study. Apart from these books, the library subscribes to 13 journals and 24 magazines to update the academic community. With modern network facilities, the library allows to access to about 80,000 e-books and 15,000 e-journals.



## COMPUTER LAB
