
ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Garden Department of University of Mysore is one of the most beautiful unit of Mysore city. The University was established in the year 1916 under the stewardship of dewan Sri. M. Visweswaraiah and support given by the then Maharaja of Mysore, His Highness Sri Nalvadi Krishnaraja Wodeyar.

The Garden Department overseas and maintains the landscapes of about 1028 Acres (411 Hecatares) of Land including University of Mysore, Hassan & Mandya Post Graduate centres.

During the year long Centenary celebrations, from 2015-2016, the department made arrangements to decorate the campus which included inaugural function of centenary celebration by Honorable President of India Late. Shri Pranab Mukherjee and 103rd Indian Science Congress by Honorable Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi, who appreciated the greenery of Campus and the valedictory function presided by Governor of Karnataka and Ex-Prime Minister of India.







1. Farm Land:

University of Mysore has an extensive farmland spread over an area of about 80 Acres/32 Hectares. These include Coconut, Sapota, Guava, Mango, Tamarind, Jack and Custard Apple and other fruit yielding trees.

The Fruits are being disposed off through online and open Auction system, every year and new plants are laid and added every year.

The Department has also planted 10000 plants of Jack Fruits, Mango, Teak, Jambulana, Beete, Honne, Rakthachandana, Mahagani, Tamarind, Neem etc. which are; highly valuable in future.

2. K.K. Tank:

Mysore University main campus has the world famous Kukkarahalli Lake. This lake is spread over an area of about 300 acres which includes water spread area and forestation. The revenue is being generated from fishing at K K Tank.


Thousands of people enjoy morning and evening walk in the K K Tank area everyday.


















6. Future Plans of Horticulture Department.
